A. Administrator's Report – Highlights of Current Information Trina shared that there are only a few bills related to Special Education this year. There are a couple that will have a fiscal impact that we are keeping an eye on. B. *FCSS Operated Programs Class Size Capacity

C. *Percentage of Students Served in County Programs by DOR T. Frazier Trina shared information regarding the percentage of students served in county-operated programs showing the percentage each district makes up of the SELPA.

D. *Funding Allocations for 2023-24 Quarter 3; & Funding Allocations for 2024-25 Estimate E. Davidson 1

Eddie Davidson, Fiscal Student Services Director, shared the handout titled "Funding Allocations for 2023-24 Quarter 3; & Funding Allocations for 2024-25 Estimate 1". Eddie reviewed the various funding sources and allocations with members.

E. *Transportation Billback Update for 2023-24 Quarter 3 & 2024-25 Estimate 1

The breakdown of costs and liquidated damages were reviewed. The current estimated cost-perrider for districts is \$8,800.
