- **Legislative Updates**

Daniel Soto SELPA Compliance Officer shared the key Legislative updates. Assembly Joint Resolution No. 7- Addis- Asking members of the US Congress to oppose reductions to funding to ensure services and funding for students with disabilities are uninterrupted. H.R. 2333- Protecting Students with Disabilities Act- To prohibit the use of appropriated funds to eliminate, consolidate, or restructure any office within the Department of Education that administers or enforces programs under IDEA.
